Northern Michigan awaits us on this delightful summer excursion. Thunder Bay Resort is a family-run resort nestled deep in the woods near Lake Huron, just an hour south of Mackinac Island. This trip includes a stop in Frankenmuth, a trip to Mackinac Island, a night at the Thunder Bay Resort, a fantastic gourmet dinner at the Antler Log Cabin, and a stop in Alpena Michigan on our way home.

THURSDAY: Our bus leaves early this morning from the Trinity Lutheran Church parking lot in Kent. Along the way, we will stop in the town of Frankenmuth, known as Michigan's "Little Bavaria." You will have the opportunity to visit Bronner's Christmas Wonderland, a fascinating year-round attraction for all ages. In the late afternoon we arrive at our lodging for this evening, the Lakeside Resort at Houghton Lake. Enjoy a dinner show, "The Gordon Lightfoot Tribute." This show replicates the songs and styles of a Gordon Lightfoot concert with songs such as "If You Could Read My Mind" and "Wreck of the Edmund Fitzgerald."

FRIDAY: After breakfast, we pack up and depart for Mackinac Island. We will board the ferry for the short crossing. Then step off the ferry and step back in time! Horse-drawn vehicles transport everything on the island from supplies to people. We will board our horse-drawn carriage for a tour of the island with time for shopping in the downtown area. There you may have lunch at your leisure and visit some of the island's unique shops. Be sure to taste some of their famous Mackinac Island Fudge. At 3:00 pm, we will depart the island and ride to the Thunder Bay Resort. Then get ready for another unique experience as we board our horse-drawn carriage and travel deep in the woods to Antler Log Cabin. Savor the delicious aromas put forth by the twin antique wood cook stoves as your gourmet meal is prepared before your eyes. Also we will enjoy a sampling of wines from nearby Stoney Acres Winery.

SATURDAY: After breakfast at the Clubhouse Grill, we depart the resort and head for the Great Lakes Heritage Center in Alpena Michigan. Explore a shipwreck without getting wet! Experience the Shipwreck Century as you battle the fury of a Lake Huron storm aboard a 19th century schooner. And something new is a display called "Science on a Sphere." It is a room-sized, global display system that uses computers and video projectors to display planetary data onto a six foot diameter sphere, just like a giant animated globe. Then we begin our departure for home with many fond memories. There will be meal stops along the way, and we return to Kent in the evening.
