Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands

Basseterre, St. Kitts

Bridgetown, Barbados

While the surroundings and weather are unmistakably Caribbean, the ambiance is decidedly British. High tea is still served nearly everywhere, examples of Victorian architecture can be found throughout the city.
